

## Lesson 9 – Trade and its impacts (Case Study)

## Trade in the UK

Trade has long been important to the United Kingdom's economy. The total value of imports and exports represents nearly half the country's GDP. The volume of both the exports and the imports of the United Kingdom has grown steadily in recent years. Main British exports include machinery, automobiles and other transport equipment, electrical and electronic equipment (including computers), chemicals, and oil. Services, particularly financial services, are another major export and contribute positively to Britain's trade. The country imports about one-tenth of its foodstuffs and about one-third of its machinery and transport equipment.
