Most people did not know very much about other countries. They learnt some things from stories.


Globalisation is a very important word in geography and one you will need to know in detail for your GCSEs.

Globalisation is the way ideas, culture (traditions and way of life), goods and people are traveling more easily around the world.


As travel is getting faster and more efficient it appears that the world is getting smaller.

Aspects of globalisation




As the world becomes more globalised nations are becoming more inter-dependent.

- 4. Which continent do most of the items you have identified come from?




