# Post 16 Further Education College

## FAQs

### November 2017

The following questions have been posed to the school by parents, governors and staff since the proposal to relocate the post 16 provision was announced in September.

**Will students from RHS get preferential places at the College?**

Yes. As one of the partner schools, RHS students will get a preferential place.

**Will there be local transport options for the students?**

Yes, if the local transport infrastructure needs additional support, the college would provide a bus service.

**How will the curriculum be structured?**

It will be a broad, mixed package of vocational and A Level courses.

**How many places will the college have?**

The building development is being designed with a view of having a maximum capacity of 650 places.

**Will staff from RHS have the opportunity to work at the College?**

Yes, both teaching and support staff have the opportunity.

**Who will be accountable for the leadership of the College? How will governance be structured?**

A Board made up of Directors from Rastrick and Trinity will lead the College. This Board will appoint the Principal and support the recruitment of the Senior Team.

**What would the College do about enrichment (particularly sport) facilities?**

The College would use the pitches of RHS and / or Trinity for team games (Football / Rugby) for training and fixtures, along with the facilities based at North Bridge Leisure Centre.

There will also be an on-site fitness suite for students and staff to use.

**Will the college provide A Level Music?**

Yes, although this provision will continue to be taught at Rastrick.
