

Proposed Admission Criteria 2022 - 23

The Published Admissions Limit (PAL) for Year 7 students at Rastrick High School is 360

- 1) Pupils who are in public care ('Looked After' children) or pupils who were previously looked after but ceased to be so because they became adopted or became subject to a child arrangements or special guardianship order.
- 2) Pupils of Carr Green Primary, Field Lane Primary, Salterhebble Junior and Infants School, Northowram Junior and Infants School, Longroyde Primary School, Copley Primary School, Woodhouse Primary School and Fixby Junior and Infant School
- 3) Those children who have a brother or sister (or step-brother or step-sister living in the same household) attending the school at the time of their admission (i.e 1 September of the relevant admission year).
- 4) Children who have a particular ability for music. Allocations under this criterion will be limited to 30 places and applications must be supported by evidence. A supplementary application form must be completed to apply under this criterion, which is available from Rastrick High School.
- 5) Children who are residents in the defined Rastrick High School catchment area.
- 6) Children will then be admitted in the order of proximity of the child's home address to the school. Distance will be calculated using a straight-line measurement from the student's home to the closest **designated** school gate. Distances will be calculated using the Local Authority's GIS system (Geographical Information System). To ensure consistency applies, all measurements will be carried out by the Local Authority's GIS system and no other method of measuring distance will be considered.
