Grammar 'Quick 10' Low-stakes tests in every 3 rd lesson will monitor knowledge/retention of high-frequency grammatical structures & vocabulary. Every 3 rd lesson will also explicitly focus on a combination of exam skills/practice (speaking; listening; reading; writing or translation) Lesson tasks will implicitly expose pupils to grammar points before the explicit teaching of grammar manipulation.
