## Year 9

Students build on prior learning as they begin to articulate their views and opinions in a variety of complex time frames which, in turn, enables them to develop as confident communicators. Through the study of topics such as 'healthy lifestyle' and 'jobs & future plans', pupils build on their cultural capital by exploring a range of social and global issues relevant to them.
